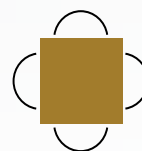

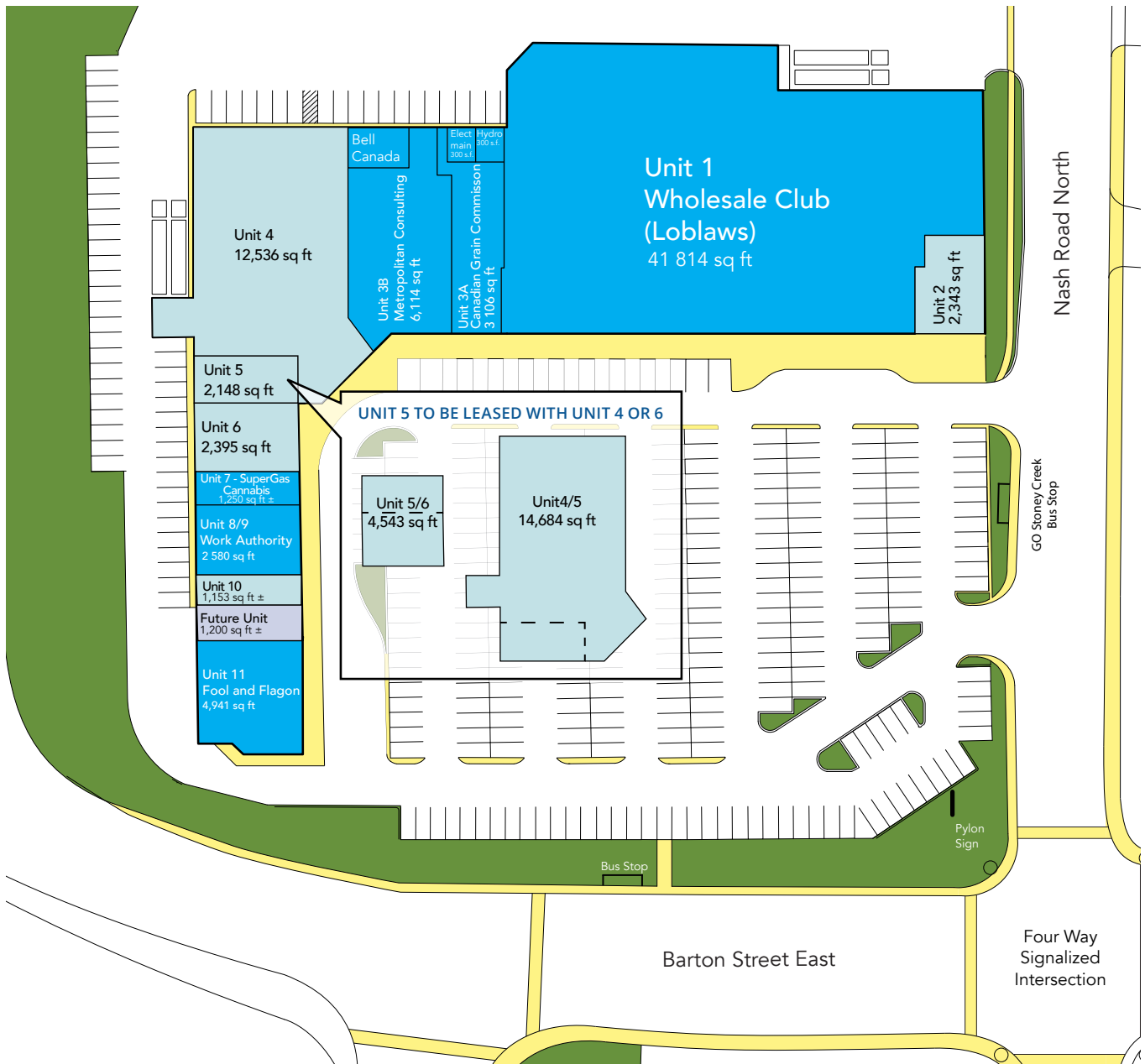

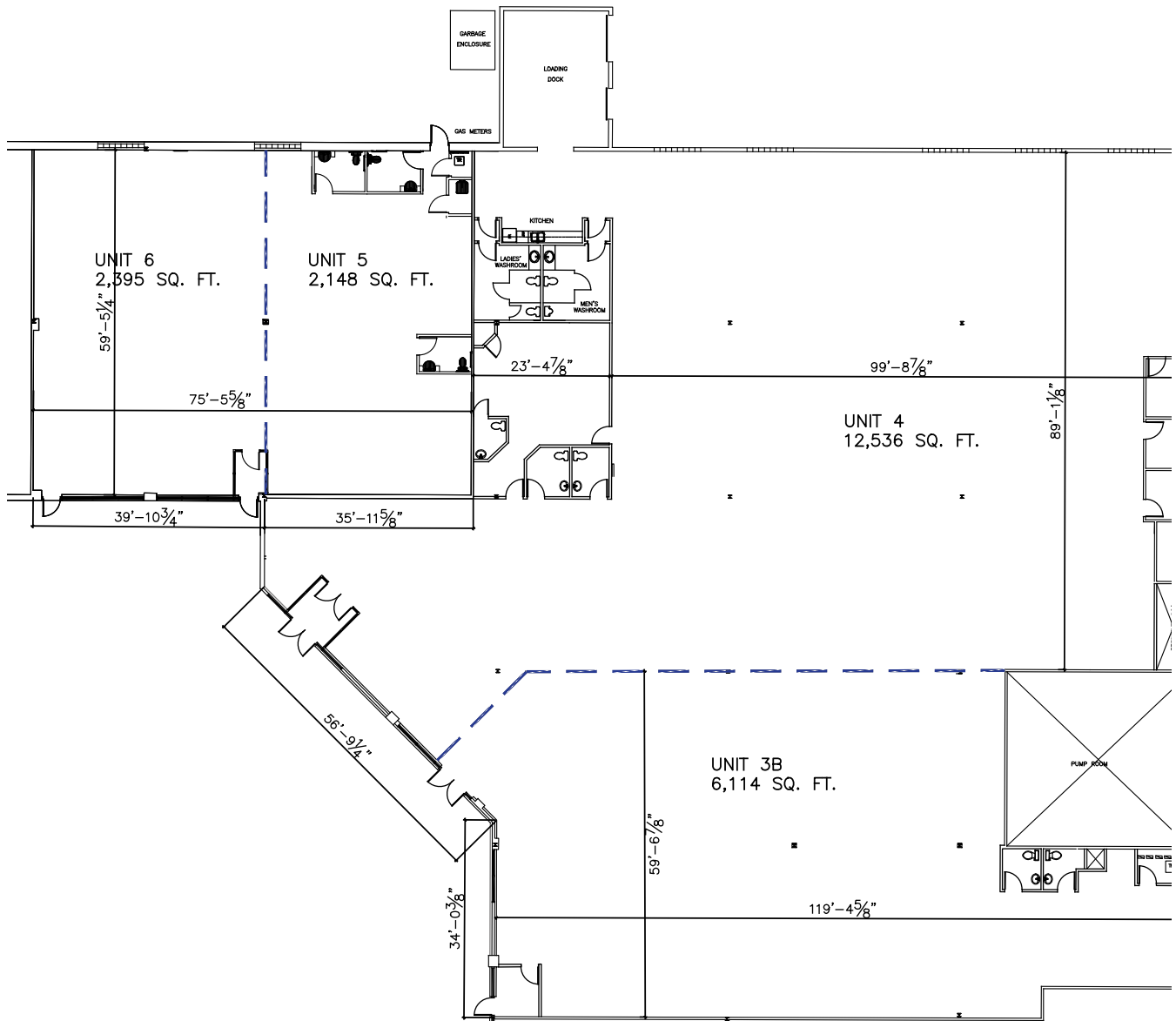
SITE PLAN

RED HILL CREEK CENTRE



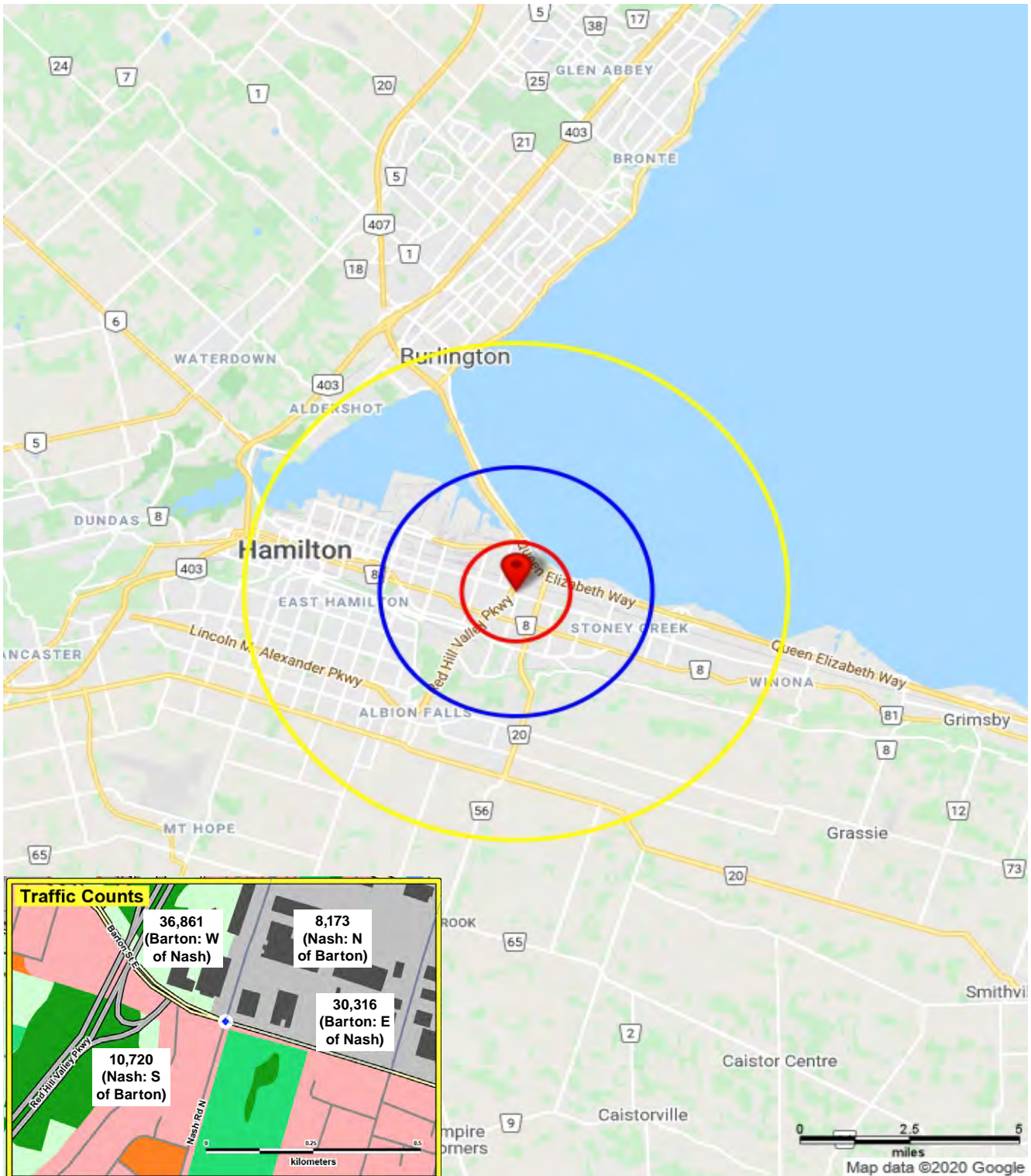
FLOOR PLAN
