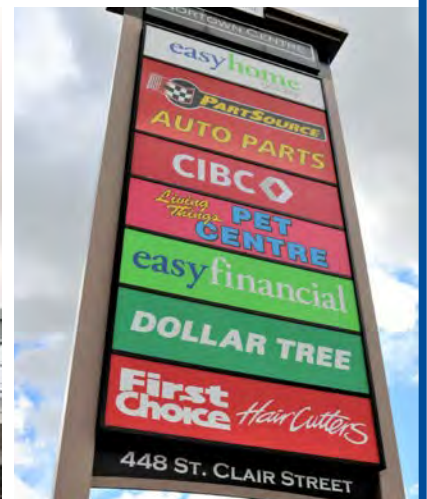


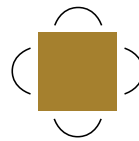

### STRATEGIC LOCATION

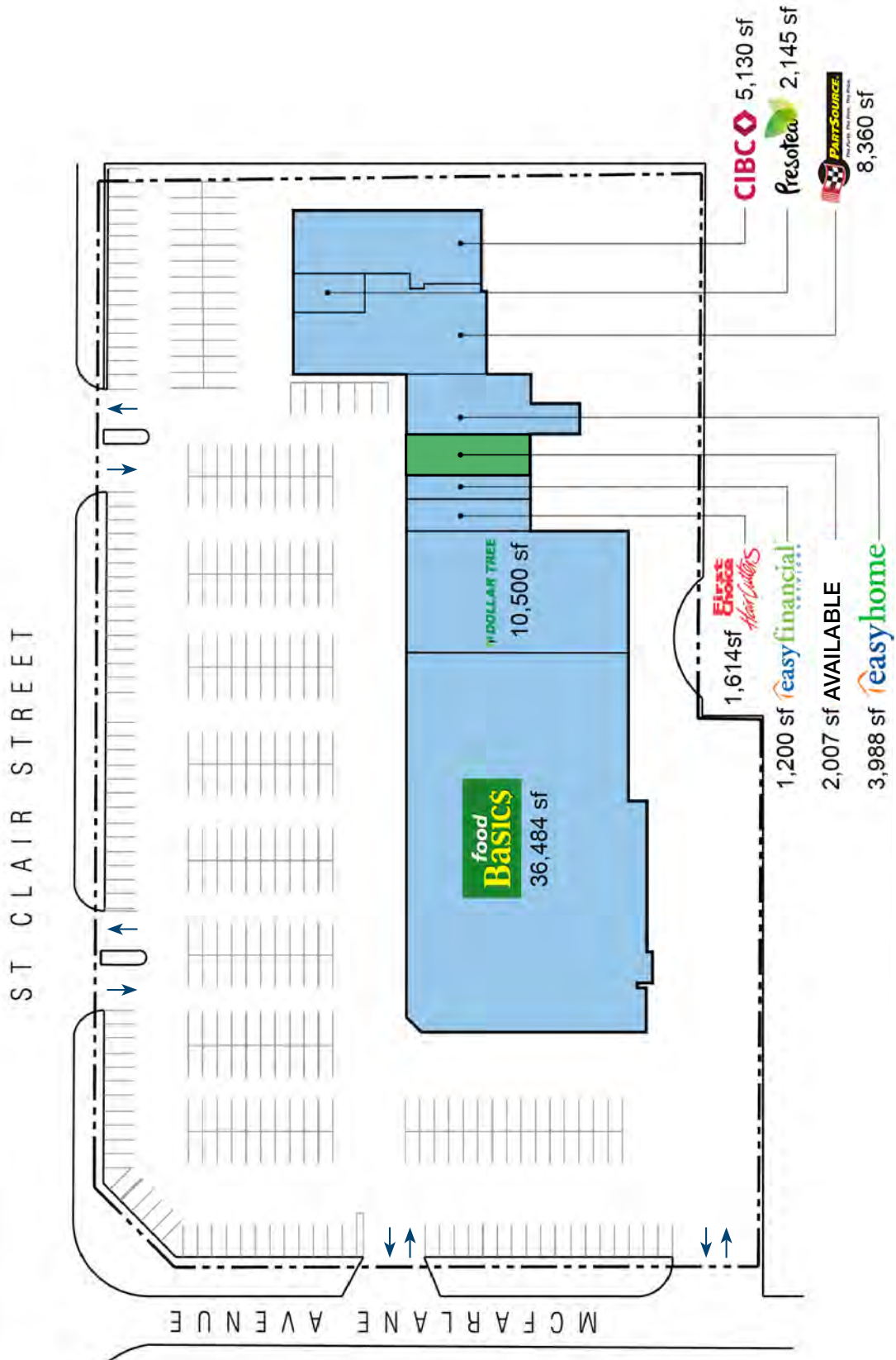

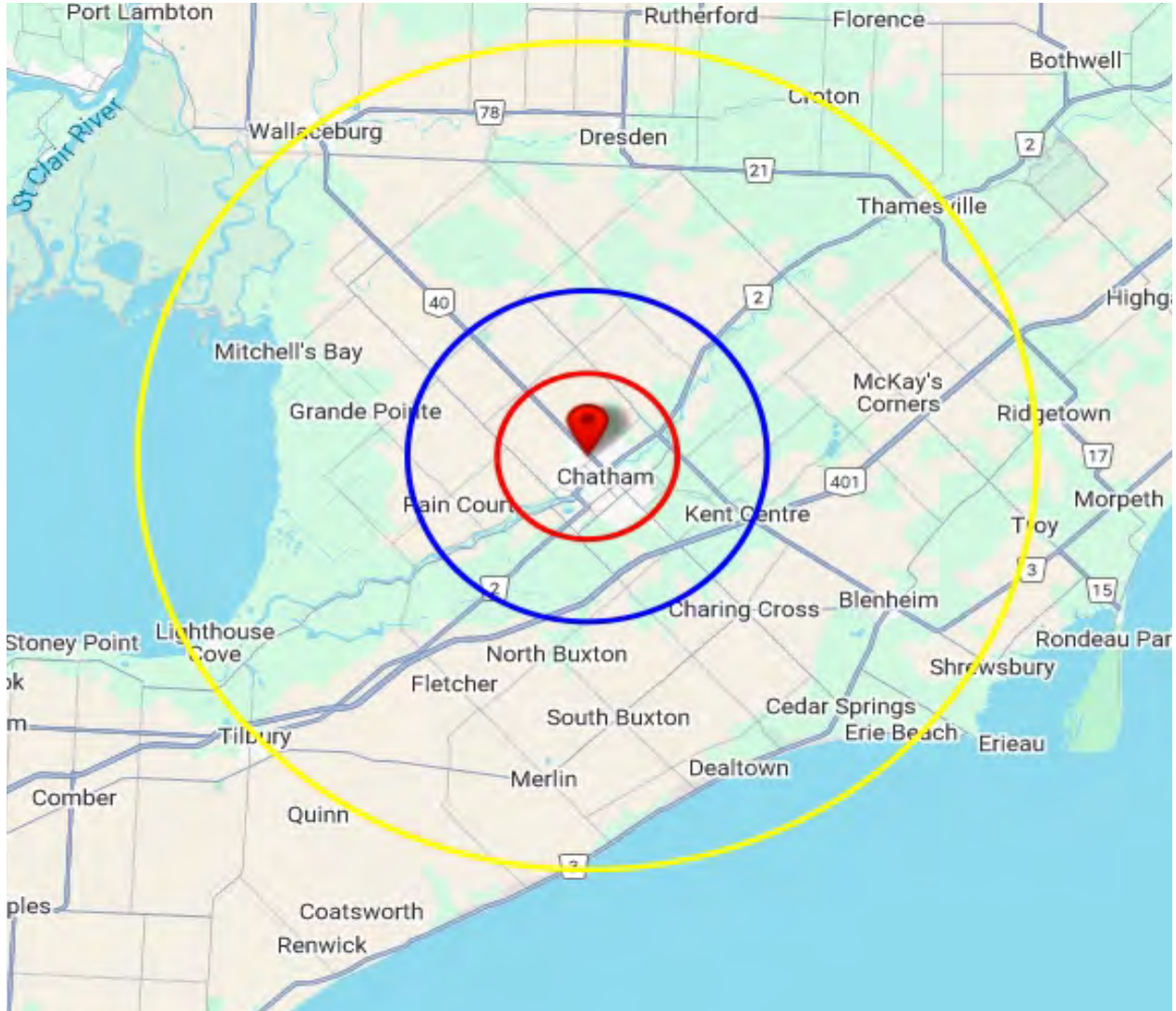
# SITE PLAN
