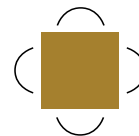

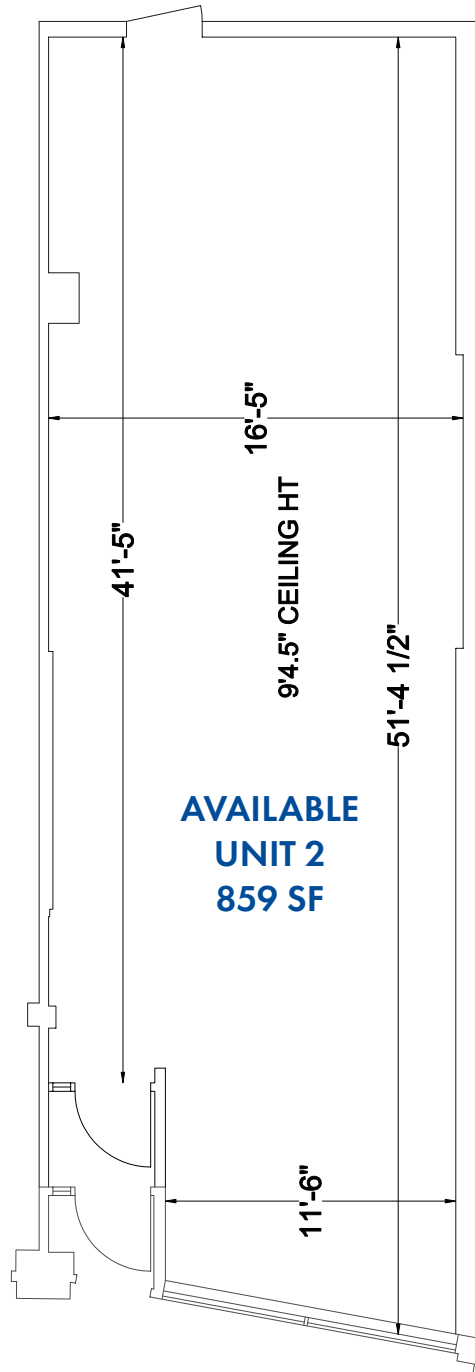
FLOOR PLAN

UNIT 1



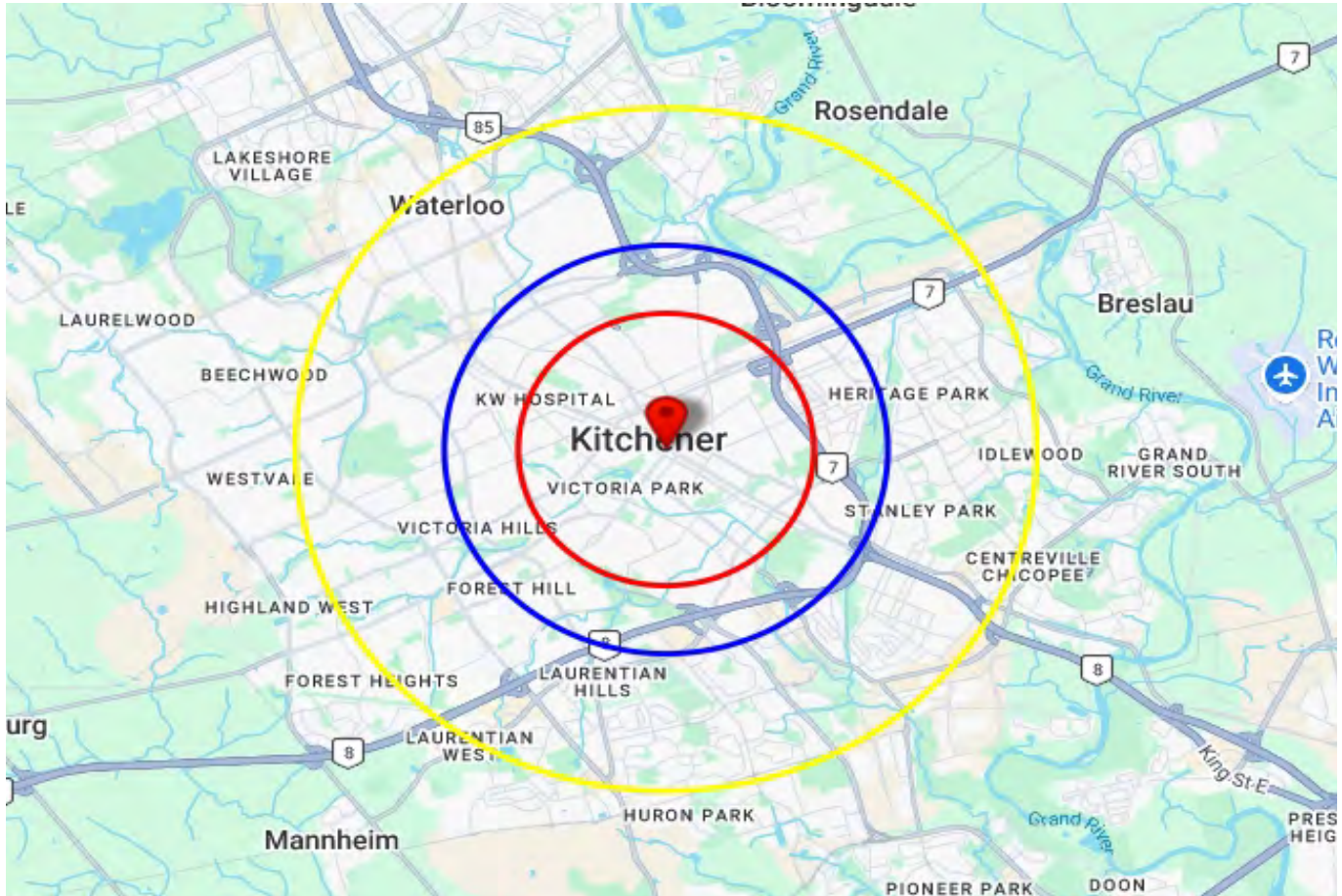
FLOOR PLAN
